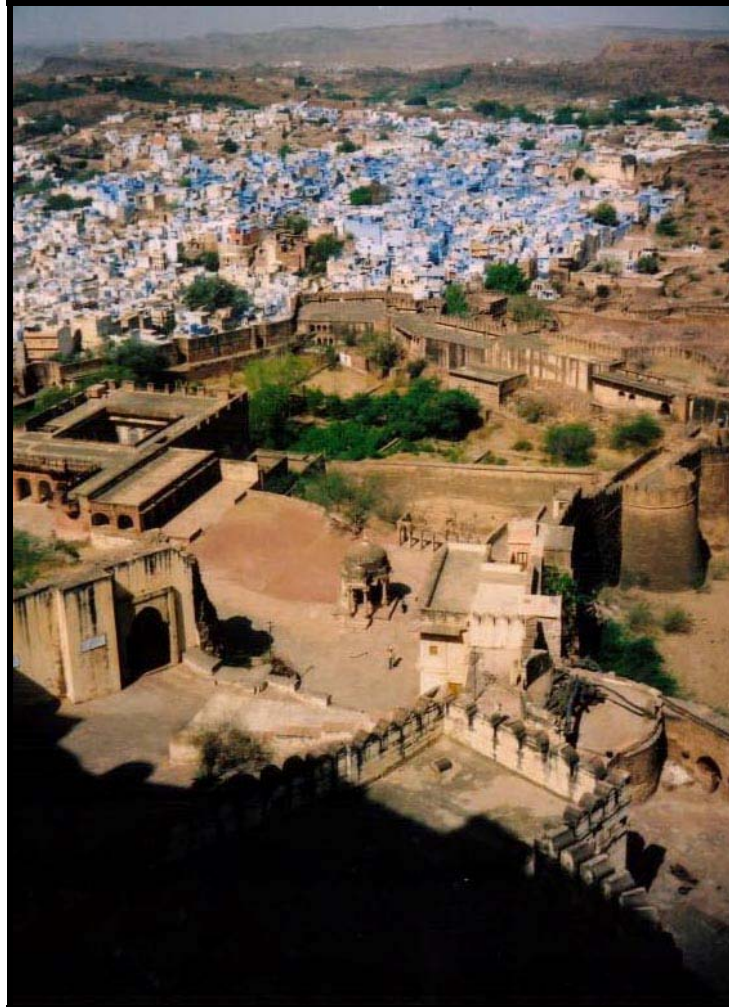
Registration now open!

The 2011 Indian Adventure will depart from the famous Taj Mahal in Agra, India on Saturday January 29th, 2011
